An emergency consists of an immediate threat, such as: **"My house is on fire" **"I think I'm having a heart attack" **"There's been a traffic accident, people are hurt" **"Someone is committing a robbery" **"I see someone trying to break into my neighbors house"		The following are not emergency circumstances: * "My car was stolen last night" * "My neighbors are playing loud music." * "There is a barking dog" Please remember that 911 is an emergency number only. All non-emergency calls can be directed to Northampton Public Safety.
